In the recent SafeWork NSW Self-Insurance Licence audit UNSW achieved a compliance score of 90.9% for Management Responsibility and 90.9% for Risk Management. This is an excellent outcome and evidence of the operational effectiveness of the UNSW Health and Safety Management System. Self-insurance saves the UNSW at least \$3-4m per year as opposed to private insurance and supports a strong safety culture across the University. It also provides personalised treatment of injured staff and improves safety outcomes overall. The audit took place over 4 days, from 12-15 April. We are now working on a plan to address the audit corrective actions and will share these as soon as available.
